EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71 - 2019

**REORGANIZING THE SECTORAL COMMITTEES OF THE
SORSOGON PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL
(SPDC) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, Section 112 of Republic Act No. 7160, states that the local development council may form sectoral or functional committees to assist the council in the performance of their functions;

WHEREAS, to ensure policy coordination and uniformity in operational directions, the sectoral or functional committees shall directly establish linkages with national government agencies for development, investment and consultative purposes;

WHEREAS, the sectoral or functional committees to be created under the Provincial Development Council shall be the following, a) Development Administration Committee (DAC), b) Economic Development Committee, c) Social Development Committee (SDC), d) Environmental Development Committee, and e) Infrastructure Development Committee (IDC);

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 211-16 dated January 31, 2011, enjoined all Local Chief Executives to create a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Sub-Committee in the local development councils (LDC) to assist the LGUs in setting the economic and social development and coordinate the development efforts as provided for in section 106 of the Local Government Code of 1991. Specifically, the PPP Sub-Committee shall, among others, assist the LDC in the formulation of action plans and strategies related to the implementation of PPP programs and projects per EO No. 8 s. 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE I, FRANCIS JOSEPH G. ESCUDERO, Governor of the Province of Sorsogon, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Composition. - The Sectoral or Functional Committees of the Provincial Development Council shall be composed of the following members:

The fourteen (14) municipal mayors and one (1) city mayor in the province shall be members of all sectoral committees while their planning and development coordinators shall be invited as regular guests. The Provincial Development Council may expand the membership of the sectoral committees to include other offices in the provincial government and national government agencies, NGOs and civil society organization, as may be necessary.

Section 2. Powers and Functions. - The SPDC Sectoral Committees shall perform the following powers and functions, to wit:

- a. Development Administration Committee (DAC), Social Development Committee (SDC), Economic Development Committee, Environmental Development Committee, and Infrastructure Development Committee (IDC).

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1. Provide the Provincial Development Council with data and information essential to the formulation of plans, programs and activities;
2. Define sectoral or functional objectives, set targets, and identify programs, projects and activities for the particular sector or function;
3. Collate and analyze information and statistics and conduct related studies;
4. Conduct public hearings on vital issues affecting the sector or function;
5. Coordinate, planning, programming, and implementation of programs projects and activities within each sector;
6. Monitor and evaluate programs and projects; and
7. Perform such other functions as may be assigned by the PDC.

b. Public-Private Partnership Sub-Committee

1. Facilitate the preparation, coordination, and execution of local economic and investment promotion policies, projects and activities of the Provincial Government;
2. Facilitate the establishment of an aggressive, systematic, coordinated, sustained promotion and marketing of the LGUs as investment location;
3. Provide basic information about business potentials of the LGU including LGU services to prospective investors to attract more investments to flow in the community;
4. Establish a local economic data base containing relevant facts and figures;
5. Coordinate with other offices in the promotion of economic activities such as the Planning and Development Treasury and Budget offices and the local sanggunian;
6. Coordinate with the private sector in investment promotion campaigns;
7. Conduct information dissemination on local government policies on investment, investment wage laws, required permits, etc.

Section 3. Sectoral Coordinator and Secretaries. - The Provincial Planning and Development Coordinator (PPDC) shall serve as the sectoral coordinator and shall be responsible for the provision of technical and administrative support to the respective sectoral committees. The secretaries of the different sectoral

committees shall be responsible for the preparation of reference folders, minutes and resolutions and custody of records, etc. The SecCom secretaries shall be composed of the following:

Section 4. Incorporation Clause. - All laws, legal orders, rules and regulations that have been issued and/or will be issued by the duly constituted authorities of the Republic of the Philippines pertaining to establishment, composition and functions of the SPDC Sectoral Committees are hereby incorporated herein and made an integral part hereof. In case of conflict, such laws, legal orders, rules and regulations shall have precedence over the provisions of this Executive Order.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. - Any Administrative Order or Executive Order previously issued that is inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order shall be considered repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity. - This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its issuance as stated hereunder.
